

Code of Conduct for Teachers

A teacher is constantly under the scrutiny of his students and the society at large. Therefore:-

- ❖ Teachers should see that there is no incompatibility between their percept and practices. Their life style should be inconsistent with the dignity of the profession.
- ❖ Teacher should seek to make professional growth continuous through study and research.
- ❖ Teacher should act with honesty and integrity in all aspects of their work.
- ❖ Teacher should represent themselves, their professional status, qualifications and experience honestly.
- ❖ Teachers should work within the framework of relevant legislation and regulations.
- ❖ Teacher should work in a collaborative manner with pupils/students, parents/guardians, school management, other members of staff, relevant professionals and the wider school community, as appropriate, in seeking to effectively meet the needs of pupils/students.
- ❖ Teacher should refrain themselves from any activity which promotes differences in the name of caste, faith, gender, languages etc.
- ❖ Teacher should respect the right and dignity of the students in expressing their opinion.
- ❖ Teacher should be affectionate to the students and not behave in vindictive manners.
- ❖ Teachers should make themselves available to the students even beyond their class hours.
- ❖ Teachers should help students to develop an understanding of our national heritage and national goals.
- ❖ Teacher should recognize the differences in attitudes and capabilities among students and strive to meet their individuals need.
- ❖ Teacher should treat challenges in same manners as they themselves wish to be treated and consider non-teaching staff as equal partners.

Code of Conduct for Students

The college lays a special emphasis on the maintenance of discipline and proper decorum in the campus and classroom-

- A student not in possession of identity card issued and duly signed by the college authority shall not be allowed to enter the college premises.
- Students must come to the college in dress appropriate to an educational institution. Shorts, miniskirts and short blouses are not allowed.
- A student shall be allowed to appear in the examination only if she attends not less than 75% of classes held.
- A student remaining absent continuously for ten days (without information) from the college shall be struck off from the rolls.
- Leave notes from parents/guardian and where needed medical certificate are to be given to principal to explain the absence of a student from class.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited.
- Students may not entertain their visitors/relatives in the campus.
- Students may not eat any places of the college beside canteen.
- Littering on the premises is punishable.
- Writing and drawing on the walls and desks is prohibited.
- Mobile phones are not allowed inside the class rooms.
